Chosen for a good portion of the business district, Chinese Flame Trees can grow up to forty feet in height. From June to August, the Flame Tree canopy is coated with bright yellow flowers, and in autumn the leaves turn yellow, pleasantly adding more color to the neighborhood. The trees in North Park have grown very quickly and are doing extremely well in our harsh soils. You can find Chinese Flame Trees on University Avenue between Texas and Boundary, and along 30th Street.
