## Mugho Pine *Pinus Mugo Mugo* 02-24

*Mugo Pine often forms a shrubby plant habit but, depending on the source, this species can be quite variable in size and form. Most develop into a dense plant with a width exceeding the height. However, trees with an erect pyramidal growth habit can occur. Seed strains that are somewhat slow growing and produce compact wide spreading plants are usually grown by the nursery industry. Mugo Pine has needles in clusters of two. Foliage is dark green and may develop a yellowish tinge in winter. Requirements and Culture: Prefers a moist loam soil. Grows best in full sun but can tolerate light shade. Often planted in landscape situations such as foundation plantings where they eventually will grow too large. Prune or break off a portion of the candles each year to keep in bounds. Transplants well, especially when container grown*
