Abelias are amongst the easiest of plants to grow in Australian gardens. 'Snow Shower'® is a slow growing compact form of Abelia grandiflora which grows easily from one end of the country to the other. By its nature of growth it is a ground cover. In a container 'Snow Shower'® gives a pleasing effect to courtyard gardens of today. Like all Abelias some flowers show all year with the main flowering in early Summer.

'Snow Shower'® can be grown in full sun but also in partial to shaded garden areas. In cottage gardens 'Snow Shower'® gives a pleasing contrast to more flamboyant flowering plants and when they are finished flowering gives the garden a substance. One could expect a neat and tidy plant growing 40-60cm in height and 1 meter in width after several years.
