## New Gold Lantana

*Lantana camara hybrid*

*New Gold Lantana is one of the best summer annuals for Arkansas gardens. It loves the heat of summer and is covered with 2-inch clusters of yellow-gold blooms from the first hot days of spring until the first killing frost. Lantana is great for use in color beds, containers on the patio or in hanging baskets. If grown in containers, be prepared to keep it watered and fertilize it once a month but otherwise it is trouble free. Butterflies love this plant for its nectar. Unlike some Lantana selections, New Gold seldom sets berries.*
