*Stout 3 foot plants produce very large clusters of dark blue flowers over a very long spring and summer season. They are excellent for fresh cut or dried arrangements. One of the best perennials for beach plantings, they are damaged by temperatures below 25 degrees F. However, it is so heavy blooming and showy it is well worth growing even where it freezes out occasionally. Prefers part shade in hot climates. Winter hardy to zone 9.*
