



## Razzel berry *Loropetalum chinense* 03-65

*Razzelberry's a show-stopper. It's got sizzling pink fringe-like flowers from late in spring to autumn and lush foliage in green and bronze hues. As autumn cools, the bronze tones intensify to produce a real garden beauty*

*Razzelberry's a rounded evergreen shrub to approximately two metres in both dimensions. Notable for its changing colours through the year; from rich green tones over summer, through autumn colours and into distinct bronze hues as the weather cools into winter. It looks brilliant during the change of temperature from autumn into winter when its bronze hues seem to shine.*

*Classic loropetalum fringe flowers of a bright pink are produced in clusters from early in spring and flush sporadically over summer and with renewed vigour late in autumn.*
