



## Indian Hawthorn Ballerina

Clean, large, deep pink flowers set this variety apart from the rest. Its foliage is tidy, in glossy green with bronze tones and it grows to around a meter in both directions. From late in winter clusters of large deep pink flowers begin to form and flush right into spring and through summer.

Features: Lovely, year-round interest, rich pink flowers from spring and into summer. Uses: Garden borders, patio pots, rockeries and shrub beds. Position: Needs full sun, a deeply worked and free-draining soil. Hardy to drought, coastal conditions and light frost. Care: Pinching out growth tips after flowering encourages bushy sideways growth. If wet conditions are common, watch for leaf-spotting and use a fungus spray. Height x Width: 1 x 1 meter.
