Indian Hawthorn 'Clara' *Raphiolepis Indica 'Clara'*

The Indian Hawthorn is great landscape shrub, low divider or informal hedge. There are a number of varieties. Clara is up to 4 feet tall (1.2 m), with mostly white flowers. Its new growth is reddish. The Indian Hawthorn likes a slightly acidic soil, use fertilizer for acid loving plants. Profuse white to dark pink blossom in late fall to early spring. The fruits are dark blue and ripen as the bush is still blooming.
