Evergreen mounds of grass-like leaves one and a half to six inches long. Spreading clumps. Blooms are rose pink, ball shaped clusters, 1/2" in diameter, late Spring-Fall. Prefers light, well drained soil. In southern zones, does best with afternoon shade. Tolerances: deer, slope, wind, poor soil. Spacing 8-12". Family: Plumbaginaceae.
